Art Market



Digital natives are the fastest growing segment of art buyers (36%, +30%YoY)*


They enjoy participating in the art world; they are financially driven; and they favor cost-sharing models.



Eve Sussman shattered her video '89 seconds at Alcazar' (\$180K, in collection of MoMA, Whitney) into 2,304 tokenized pieces (Atoms) to sell on the blockchain.



Through social interaction of owners the piece got a life with upcoming screening scheduled in NY, Germany and Kazakhstan.



Buy Some Cookies

10,000 unique cookies will go on sale for \$1 each. 400 of 10,000 codes was cracked by owners.

10,000 short poems from Mr. Fox are placed into crypto-cookies.



Buy and sell unopened cookies on an open market.



Crack a cookie to read a poem but you can't sell it anymore.



Poetry from cracked cookies become a part of the public domain.

This means when your cookie is cracked and poetry is revealed, the cracked cookie loses its monetary value which is passed on to the remaining cookie owners. The fewer cookies left on the market, the more expensive the remaining cookies are. Also an opened cookie is a public good because all poems become a public domain. To hold a cookie is a personal interest but crack a cookie is a public. Make your move.



Whilst held, a 5% fee (pa) is levied as patronage towards the artist.


